



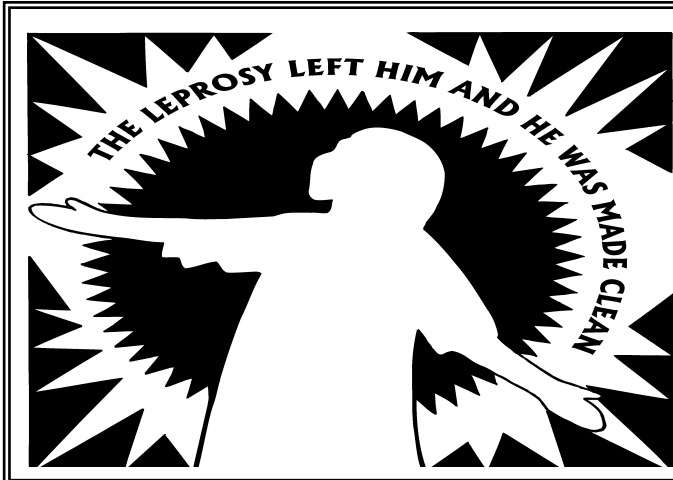

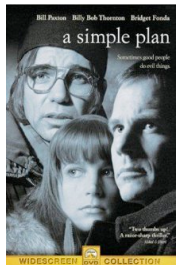

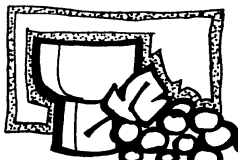

**CHRISTIAN FORMATION**

**FIRST EUCHARIST PARENTS:** Our next session is Bread Baking Day on Sat., March 10, 9:00am until noon. Parents (at least one **from each family**) and children will gather promptly at 9:00am to bake bread under the direction of Al Reynolds. While our bread is baking, children will attend workshops during which they will view a video, listen to a story, and make a craft all based on the Eucharist, as well as practice receiving Communion with unconsecrated bread and wine. The morning will conclude with a family meal of the baked bread, breads from other cultures, and grape juice, which will cause all to reflect on the meaning of Eucharist.

**HELPING CHILDREN UNDERSTAND BODY LANGUAGE OF MASS:** **Praying with hands open** as the priest does for many prayers during the Mass. Praying in this posture is a way of opening ourselves to receive the graces that flow during the Mass. Try praying this way at home with your children. **Standing** is one of the oldest postures of prayer. We stand during the opening procession and at other times during the Mass, for the Gospel, as well as for certain prayers such as the Lord's Prayer and the Prayers of the Faithful. Have children stand when the congregation stands, so that children understand that we do special things as a group, because God is there with us. The Mass is not just where adults participate, and children wait until its over. **Bowing** is a common gesture of reverence in many cultures. We bow before receiving Eucharist. *Third in a series on deepening your family's participation at the Mass excerpted from "At Home with our Faith" by Annemarie Scobey.*

## **JUSTICE AND CHARITY MINISTRY**

**PARISHIONERS IN NEED OF RIDE TO MASS:** Two parish households need help getting to Mass. One family (a mother and child on St. Clair Avenue) lacks a car and needs transportation to Mass on Sundays at 9:00am; the other individual would like to attend Mass during the week and possibly on Sundays but is not physically able to drive. Please contact Kristen in the Parish Office if you are available to help with one or both of these needs!

**TAKE ACTION TO HELP OUR IMMIGRANT BROTHERS & SISTERS:** As you may know, there are many anti-immigrant bills being considered in our state House and Senate this year that will negatively and deeply affect our immigrant brothers and sisters across Virginia, regardless of their authorization status. Our Church teaches that, while sovereign states do have the right to control their borders, people also have the rights to find opportunities in their homelands and, if that is not possible, to migrate to support themselves and their family. Above all, we believe that human dignity and human rights of every migrant—documented or not—must be respected, and much of the legislation that is proposed does not uphold this. You are encouraged to write a letter to your senator and delegate urging them to vote against punitive, anti-immigrant bills. More background information and details about what this letter might entail can be found on purple sheets in the Narthex or on the Justice & Charity page of the website under “Immigration Reform.” Thank you for being a voice for and standing alongside those in our parish and state not born in the United States.

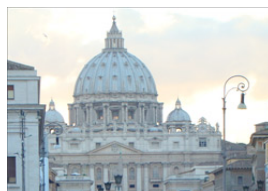
**IMPACT:** Did you know that, while the overall unemployment rate in Charlottesville is low at 4.2%, those under the age of 30 are three times more likely to be unemployed (14%)? This is a staggering disproportionality! Learn more about this problem on our parish website under “IMPACT,” and plan now to attend the **Rally** at Incarnation on **Monday, March 5 (6:30pm)** and, most importantly, the **Nehemiah Action**, where all 32 congregations gather together to make proposals to officials that promote a more just community, at JPJ Arena on **Monday, March 26 (6:30pm)**. We have a biblical call to be seekers of justice, and IMPACT allows our faith community to do just that!

**FOOD MINISTRY REQUEST FOR HELP:** Our Parish Food Ministry is currently serving 62 families experiencing food insecurity, providing a much-needed service that, as we hear repeatedly, helps to alleviate one of the worries these families have—where their meals will come from. In the three years since the ministry began, food donations have ebbed and flowed, but they have not kept up with the current demand due to the large number of families needing assistance. Can you consider picking up an extra can of tomatoes or tuna, a bag of beans or oranges, or a box of cereal each time you go to the grocery store? Can you donate the same items each month through our Adopt-A-Family program? Reaching out to those in need and helping to meet their most basic requirements is an imperative of our faith, and this is an easy way that you can participate. Please place your donations in the basket in the Narthex.



**OUR GREEN TEAM**, which coordinates the new Community Garden (whose produce will go to our Parish Food Ministry) and is working on developing more sustainable practices at Incarnation, is in need of a variety of things—donations and time—as we continue our work and prepare for our spring growing season! Please bring donations to the Parish Office or leave them in the kitchen of the Parish Hall, and contact Kristen if you'd like to give of your time.

- Time. We need **garden volunteers** of all ages and levels of expertise to plant, water, weed, serve as garden consultants, harvest, etc. No experience is necessary, and we will have a volunteer kick-off and plenty of resources to help you learn as you go throughout the gardening season ahead!
- Garden donations. To do our work, we need: **produce scale**, **garden hose & nozzle**, new or gently used **garden tools** (spades/trowels, forks, weeders, etc.), **old t-shirts** (to use for trellis ties), **small storage bench/box**.
- Dish donations. In order to decrease our reliance on resource-intensive disposable dishes, we would like to have reusable dishes available in both the PAC and the Parish Hall for group events. We need gently-used **flatware** (forks, spoons, knives) and sets of **plates**, **bowls**, and **dessert plates** (all microwave/dishwasher safe).

**Episode IV: “OUR TAINTED NATURE’S SOLITARY BOAST: MARY, THE MOTHER OF GOD”:** In this episode, Fr. Mary is explained as “an on-going presence, an actor in the life of the Church.” Fr.
